### COMMON DIAGNOSES WORDING

It will be helpful for audit purposes if diagnoses are worded as follows (this list is not exhaustive):

Age related macular degeneration	Keratitis
- Wet (AMD-W)	- bacterial
- Dry (AMD-D)	- viral
Blepharitis	Hordeolum (Stye)
Cataract	Iritis
Chalazion	kerato-cojunctivitis sicca dry eye
Conjunctivitis	Meibomian Gland Dysfunction (MGD)
- bacterial	
- viral	Optic neuritis
- allergic	Papilloedema
- seasonal allergic (SAC)	Posterior capsular opacification (PCO)
- acute allergic (AAC)	Posterior vitreal detachment (PVD)
- perennial allergic (PAC)	
Closed angle glaucoma (CAG)	Pre-retinal haemorrhage
Corneal ulcer (position on cornea- marginal or central and depth recorded)	Proliferative diabetic retinopathy (PDR)
- infected	Retinal tear(s)
- sterile	Scleritis
- viral	Subconjunctival haemorrhage
- dendritic	Trichiasis
Ectropion	Uveitis
Entropion	Vitreal haemorrhage
Episcleritis	kerato-cojunctivitis sicca dry eye
Foreign Body (type, position, depth of FB and describe lesion after removal)	Meibomian Gland Dysfunction (MGD)
