COMMON DIAGNOSES WORDING

It will be helpful for audit purposes if diagnoses are worded as follows (this list is not exhaustive):

Age related macular degeneration <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Wet (AMD-W) - Dry (AMD-D) 	Keratitis <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - bacterial - viral
Blepharitis	Hordeolum (Stye)
Cataract	Iritis
Chalazion	kerato-cojunctivitis sicca dry eye
Conjunctivitis <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - bacterial - viral - allergic - seasonal allergic (SAC) - acute allergic (AAC) - perennial allergic (PAC) 	Meibomian Gland Dysfunction (MGD)
Closed angle glaucoma (CAG)	Optic neuritis
Corneal ulcer (position on cornea-marginal or central and depth recorded) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - infected - sterile - viral - dendritic 	Papilloedema
Ectropion	Posterior capsular opacification (PCO)
Entropion	Posterior vitreal detachment (PVD)
Episcleritis	Pre-retinal haemorrhage
Foreign Body (type, position, depth of FB and describe lesion after removal)	Proliferative diabetic retinopathy (PDR)
